Professional Conduct Tribunal – 24 November 2014

Member bankrupt – Justin Peter Owen CA (annulled 25 May 2015)

At a hearing of the Professional Conduct Tribunal of Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand (then known as the Institute of Chartered Accountants Australia) held on 24 November 2014 in relation to Justin Peter Owen a chartered accountant of Victoria the Tribunal found a case established on his own admission that the member was liable to disciplinary action in accordance with By-law 40(h) in that on 5 July 2013 he became a bankrupt.

The Professional Conduct Tribunal ordered that:

- Justin Peter Owen's membership of Chartered Accountants ANZ (then known as the Institute of Chartered Accountants Australia) be cancelled whilst he remains an undischarged bankrupt.
- Notification of the Tribunal's decisions be given to the Australian Securities and Investments Commission and Finsia.
- The member be required to pay a contribution of \$2,700 plus GST towards the costs of the disciplinary action.
